DISSECTING THE NOVEL

Have you ever heard the comment, "If you read what we have you will know what we want"? Have you ever been confused as to which publisher or editor you should send your work to? This class answers those questions.

Scott takes you on an in-depth study of the components of a strong dissection of a novel. At the end of the session, writers will have an opportunity to dissect their own work as well and develop a strategic plan as to where they should best send their work.

Depending on how much time writers spend on their own work, this session can range from 1-3 hours.

FINDING YOUR NICHE

Ever try and figure out where you fit in this huge writing world? Scott explores the concept of finding your place. In this session, writers will learn to understand their own writing to determine if they are ready to submit manuscripts and who they should send their manuscripts to.

This session is roughly 1 hour in length although it can be expanded to a 2 hour session with some additional work time for writers.

AGENT SEARCH 101

So, you think you're ready for an agent. How do you determine the best agent for you? This session assists writers to examine their own writing goals and dreams and then develop criteria for what to look for in an agent.

This session can also be expanded into a discussion of the steps for acquiring agents as well as agent-writer partnerships.

MARKETING YOUR STORY TO EDITORS AND AGENTS

This is a full day session and encompasses many of the smaller sessions. During the session writers will:

1. Determine if they are ready to submit
2. Determine their own niche in the writing world
3. Learn how to find the best agent and editor for their work
4. Learn to write an effective query letter
5. Learn to write an effective synopsis

Prepare a query and synopsis

BEING THE PROFESSIONAL STORY PITCHER

This session is designed to assist writer in preparing their stories for pitching to editors and agents. Scott has designed this session in three parts. The first focuses on preparing written pitches (i.e. the query letter, synopsis and packaging of the manuscript). The second focuses on pitching the story in person. And the final section focuses on a hands-on approach including pitch critiques and/or a chance to practice writing queries.

This session is a minimum of 3 hours.

SEMI-COLONS ARE COOL!

Grammar is often a daunting subject for writers. Take advantage of Scott's 17 years of experience teaching writing and grammar. Learn the basics of grammar

This session would best be done in no less than 2 hours. This would give writers a chance to practice their skills.
